

Golden Bridges Infectious Disease Policy

Golden Bridges is committed to maintaining a safe and healthy environment for our customers and team members. We will follow the CDC guidelines as it relates to the workplace and home as it relates to infectious disease, including COVID-19 prevention and containment. These best practices were established to protect our clients, the communities in which we work and our team members, and are intended to supplement the CDC guidelines.

The best practices when associates show symptoms or are sick:

If a team member has symptoms of respiratory illness (such as coughing and fever) they will not come to work until they no longer have such symptoms, regardless of cause, and are free of a fever for at least 24 hours. If a team member is on the job and either arrives with symptoms or become sick during the day, they will return home.

If a team member is not comfortable working on a job site, they can notify an Owner or Team Lead.

Best practices on the job:

- Frequently wash hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.
- Clean hands often with a hand sanitizer that has at least 60 - 95% alcohol
- Wash hands or use hand sanitizer as upon arrival at the client's home, community or other workplaces.

- Wash hands or use hand sanitizer when leaving client's home or workplace
- Wipe down with sanitary wipes containing disinfectant any areas that are commonly and frequently touched such as light switches and doorknobs when leaving the client's home or workplace
- Team leads will request that any contractor working in the client's home follow the above guidelines
